

6th - 8th Grade Fee's and Requirements

Fall Fundraiser

To be band booster members there is a minimum of a \$50 buy out. This can be achieved by selling 10 items or more in the fall fundraiser. You can sell all 10 items or more for the \$50 or in any combination i.e. sell 5 items and pay \$25; sell 8 and pay \$10. It is to your family's benefit to be a member although it is not required, but by choosing not to be member it will result in addition costs to you through out the year. Examples of some (not all) additional expenses are below:

*These fees are only estimates non-members will be billed for each event separately.

** **ONLY ESTIMATES** (amounts used for example) depends on fundraising and Secret Santa Shop.

Volunteer hours

Each family is required to work the following (per child):

- Two events (See Volunteer Opportunities Form)
- 4 hours for Secret Santa
- 4 hours for IGSMMA district contest.

Sign-up for events are on a "first come first serve" basis. Sign-up's can be done online through an email that will be sent out, or by contacting the Volunteer Coordinator, Laura Vanderhei at vanderhei@att.net.

We will be collecting a deposit check for \$200.00 made out to Manhattan Band Boosters and post marked May 31, 2018. This check will NOT be cashed unless these requirements are not met by the end of the school year. Check will be returned to you at uniform turn-in.

Uniform Distribution

We will be collecting a \$15.00 check for uniform dry cleaning. This check will be cashed now. We will also be collecting a deposit check for \$50.00 postmarked for May 31, 2018. This \$50 deposit check will NOT be cashed unless there is damage to the uniform.
